VERSE 1 <sup>D</sup> Behold, the <sup>G</sup> Servant of the <sup>A</sup> Lord, <sup>B</sup>  
<sup>G</sup> In whom His soul <sup>D</sup> delights.  
<sup>D</sup> Our great Redeemer, <sup>G</sup> Christ, the <sup>A</sup> Word, <sup>B</sup>  
<sup>G</sup> Whose burden load is <sup>A</sup> light. <sup>D</sup>  
<sup>G</sup> The smoking flax He <sup>Bm7</sup> does not <sup>A</sup> quench;  
<sup>G</sup> He binds the broken <sup>Bm7</sup> reed. <sup>A</sup>  
<sup>G</sup> His heart is <sup>Bm7</sup> gentle, <sup>A</sup> Come, find rest –  
<sup>G</sup> The sinner He <sup>A</sup> receives. <sup>D</sup>

VERSE 2 <sup>D</sup> Behold, th'incarnate <sup>G</sup> Son of <sup>A</sup> God, <sup>B</sup>  
<sup>G</sup> With man He makes His <sup>D</sup> home.  
<sup>D</sup> Our humble Lord <sup>G</sup> descends to us <sup>B</sup>  
<sup>G</sup> Within the virgin's <sup>A</sup> womb. <sup>D</sup>  
<sup>G</sup> In Bethlehem a <sup>Bm7</sup> child is <sup>A</sup> born;  
<sup>G</sup> To us a Son is <sup>Bm7</sup> giv'n. <sup>A</sup>  
<sup>G</sup> He comes to give His <sup>Bm7</sup> people <sup>A</sup> life,  
<sup>G</sup> And save them from <sup>A</sup> their <sup>D</sup> sin.

VERSE 3 <sup>D</sup> Behold, the <sup>G</sup> Son of <sup>A</sup> David <sup>B</sup> comes;  
<sup>G</sup> He rides the lowly <sup>D</sup> foal.  
<sup>D</sup> Despised, He <sup>G</sup> boasts no <sup>A</sup> majesty <sup>B</sup>  
<sup>G</sup> And takes thorns for <sup>A</sup> His <sup>D</sup> crown.  
<sup>G</sup> His name assigned with <sup>Bm7</sup> wicked <sup>A</sup> men  
<sup>G</sup> Though lies He <sup>Bm7</sup> uttered <sup>A</sup> none.  
<sup>G</sup> Whose grief is like <sup>Bm7</sup> unto our <sup>A</sup> Lord,  
<sup>G</sup> The blameless, <sup>A</sup> holy <sup>D</sup> One.

VERSE 4    <sup>D</sup> Behold the <sup>G</sup> Sacrificial <sup>A</sup> Lamb, <sup>B</sup>  
                  <sup>G</sup> For Adam's race He died.  
                  <sup>D</sup> His righteousness is giv'n to us; <sup>B</sup>  
                  <sup>G</sup> By faith we're justified.  
                  <sup>G</sup> Christ pierced for our iniquities; <sup>Bm7</sup> <sup>A</sup>  
                  <sup>G</sup> His stripes have brought us nigh. <sup>Bm7</sup> <sup>A</sup>  
                  <sup>G</sup> God's wrath forever satisfied – <sup>Bm7</sup> <sup>A</sup>  
                  <sup>G</sup> Atonement now supplied.

VERSE 5    <sup>D</sup> Behold, the <sup>G</sup> Shepherd of the church, <sup>A</sup> <sup>B</sup>  
                  <sup>G</sup> The Guardian of our souls.  
                  <sup>D</sup> He intercedes on our behalf, <sup>A</sup> <sup>B</sup>  
                  <sup>G</sup> Before the Father's throne. <sup>D</sup>  
                  <sup>G</sup> He works in us obedience, <sup>Bm7</sup> <sup>A</sup>  
                  <sup>G</sup> According to His will; <sup>Bm7</sup> <sup>A</sup>  
                  <sup>G</sup> And brings us blameless to the throne – <sup>Bm7</sup> <sup>A</sup>  
                  <sup>G</sup> His promise to fulfill.

VERSE 6    <sup>D</sup> Behold, our King will come again – <sup>B</sup>  
                  <sup>G</sup> His people to reclaim.  
                  <sup>D</sup> The bride of Christ prepares herself <sup>A</sup> <sup>B</sup>  
                  <sup>G</sup> With garments white, unstained.  
                  <sup>G</sup> Henceforth we shall forevermore <sup>Bm7</sup> <sup>A</sup>  
                  <sup>G</sup> Take up the great refrain: <sup>Bm7</sup> <sup>A</sup>  
                  <sup>G</sup> Sing, "Hallelujah to our God; <sup>Bm7</sup> <sup>A</sup>  
                  <sup>G</sup> The Lamb forever reigns!" <sup>A</sup> <sup>D</sup>
